HAVE WORKED IN THE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH FIELD FOR APPROXIMATELY 17 YEARS, MOST OF THAT TIME IN SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER TREATMENT. MY OBSERVATION HAS BEEN THAT SAFE, STABLE HOUSING IS ONE OF THE MAIN INDICATORS TO PROMOTE LONG TERM RECOVERY. MANY INDIVIDUALS WHO ENTER RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT SERVICES WILL NOT HAVE HOUSING THAT IS SUPPORTIVE TO THEIR RECOVERY EFFORTS, NOR THE RESOURCES TO ACCESS TRANSITIONAL LIVING OR RECOVERY RESIDENCE (SOBER LIVING) OPTIONS WHICH MAY BE AVAILABLE. THERE ARE MANY GAPS IN THE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SYSTEM, AND WHEN I LEARNED OF THE SOBRIETY FOUNDATION'S EFFORTS TO ASSIST IN FILLING THIS GAP, I WAS INTERESTED IN BEING PART OF THE FOUNDATION. SINCE BEING A MEMBER OF THE SOBRIETY FOUNDATION I HAVE WITNESSED THE NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS WHICH THE FOUNDATION HAS BEEN ABLE TO PROVIDE SCHOLARSHIPS TO ALLOW FOR A SUCCESSFUL TRANSITION FROM RESIDENTIAL SERVICES TO A TRADITIONAL COMMUNITY-BASED SETTING.

IN 2011, A SMALL GROUP SIT AROUND A KITCHEN TABLE AND DECIDED THAT WE ALL WANTED TO START A NON-PROFIT THAT FUNDS SOBER LIVING, SINCE WE FELT IT WAS A VERY IMPORTANT PART OF THE RECOVERY PROCESS AND IS NOT FUNDED BY INSURANCE. WE FELT LIKE IT WAS A BRIDGE FROM THE INITIAL 30 to 60-day rehab to real life. My son, Karson, had JUST PASSED AWAY FROM A DRUG OVERDOSE SO | REALLY WANTED TO WORK WITH THE UTAH'S RECOVERY COMMUNITY. HE HAD GONE TO 5 REHAB PLACES BUT WOULD NEVER DO THE SOBER LIVING PORTION WHICH I FEEL WOULD HAVE BEEN VERY BENEFICIAL WITH WORKING BACK INTO REAL LIFE BY LIVING WITH SOBER COMPANIONS, GETTING A DIFFERENT JOB THAN HE HAD WHEN HE WAS UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF DRUGS, AND WAS HELD ACCOUNTABLE IN THE SOBER LIVING HOME BY RANDOM DRUG TESTS. SINCE WE GOT OUR NON-PROFIT STATUS IN 2012, WE HAVE GIVEN OUT OVER 1700 3-MONTH, 2-MONTH AND 1-MONTH SCHOLARSHIPS FOR SOBER LIVING.

I SPEAK REGULARLY AT JAILS AND INSTITUTIONS AND SHARE OPENLY ABOUT MY MISTAKES, AND WHAT IT TOOK TO MOVE PAST THEM.

SOBRIETY TO ME HAS BEEN AN EXTREMELY WONDERFUL GIFT. I HAVE BEEN ABLE TO MAINTAIN MY SOBRIETY FOR OVER 20 YEARS WITH THE HELP OF GOD AND MANY FRIENDS AND FAMILY. I BEGAN WORKING IN THE ADDICTION MEDICINE IN 2006. I HAVE BEEN LUCKY ENOUGH TO WORK AT QUITE A FEW TREATMENT CENTERS. I HAVE SEEN THE POWER OF RECOVERY IN PEOPLE'S LIVES. HOWEVER, I HAVE ALSO WATCHED TOO MANY PEOPLE DIE. THIS DISEASE KILLS PEOPLE. THIS IS THE REASON I AM GRATEFUL TO BE ON THE BOARD AT THE SOBRIETY FOUNDATION. SOBRIETY FOUNDATION GIVES PEOPLE TOOLS TO HELP THEM IN EARLY RECOVERY, AT A TIME WHEN MANY PEOPLE DON'T HAVE RESOURCES OR TOOLS. I AM GRATEFUL FOR THE WORK WE DO AND PROUD TO BE ON THEIR BOARD.

BRIGHTON RECOVERY CENTER IS A DUAL DIAGNOSIS RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT PROGRAM. WE OFFER INDIVIDUALIZED TREATMENT FOR PEOPLE SUFFERING FROM ADDICTION AND MENTAL HEALTH ISSUES. OUR CONTINUUM OF CARE INCLUDES RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT, DAY TREATMENT, INTENSIVE OUTPATIENT TREATMENT, AND SOBER LIVING. THE CLINICAL PROGRAM IS ROOTED IN EVIDENCE-BASED MODALITIES WHICH INCLUDE CBT, DBT, ACT, AND RELAPSE PREVENTION IN ADDITION TO THE INCORPORATION OF 12-STEP EDUCATION AND PHILOSOPHY. OUR THERAPISTS SPECIALIZE IN TRAUMA INTERVENTION, AND ARE TRAINED IN EMDR, EFT, AND GOTTMAN'S SOUND RELATIONSHIP HOUSE. IN ADDITION, WE SPECIALIZE IN TREATING UNDERREPRESENTED POPULATIONS SUCH AS THE LGBTQ* DEMOGRAPHIC. WE ALSO EXCEL IN TREATING TRUE DUAL DIAGNOSIS CASES IN ADDITION MENTAL HEALTH PRIMARY CASES.

Individual treatment includes individual sessions with a master's level clinician in addition to a weekly family session. Family programming includes family therapy, weekly family groups, and a monthly family program.


